

RESOLUTION NO. 13-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT CORPORAL GLENN OESTERLING FROM THE AMITY TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Loudermill hearings regarding Corporal Glenn Oesterling ("Oesterling") were held on July 3, 2013 and September 4, 2013.

WHEREAS, a Statement of Charges ("Statement of Charges") was issued by Chief of Police Kent Shuebrook to Corporal Glenn Oesterling ("Oesterling") on September 5, 2013;

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors conducted a Police Tenure Act (53 P.S. 811) Hearing ("hearing") regarding Oesterling on September 10, 2013;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors took evidence at the Hearing and considered it carefully;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors found the evidence presented at the Hearing to be credible, convincing and proved the elements of the violations set forth in the Statement of Charges.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township hereby terminate the employment of Corporal Glenn Oesterling for the reasons set forth in the Statement of Charges issued by Chief Ken Shuebrook having found that all of the charges set forth therein were met and proved with credible and convincing evidence. The Statement of Charges is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This action shall be effective this 18th day of September, 2013.


