A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN SUBMITTED TO AMITY TOWNSHIP BY THE AMITY TOWNSHIP IMPACT FEE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Amity Township passed Resolution No. 14-03 on January 15, 2014, creating the Traffic Impact Fee Advisory Committee ("Advisory Committee") pursuant to Act 209 of 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee has submitted a Capital Improvements Plan to the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township for the implementation of impact fees for capital improvements; and

WHEREAS the LUAR updates the demographic statistics provided in the most recent Land Use Assumptions Report dated June 2014 which was prepared as part of the Amity Township Act 209 Study adopted in 2006; and

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township desires to take action on the Capital Improvements Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Amity does hereby resolve as follows:

- 1. The Capital Improvements Plan dated December 17, 2014 by Bogia Engineering, Inc. and prepared for the Amity Township Impact Fee Advisory Committee in hereby approved; and
- 2. This Resolution is enacted in order to comply with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, and in particular Section 504-A(e)(1), (2) and (3) of the Code.
