### RESOLUTION NO. 20-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING THE AMITY TOWNSHIP AGRICULTURAL SECURITY AREA PLAN, AS MODIFIED

WHEREAS, on September 4, 1990 the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of the Township of Amity, Berks County, Pennsylvania (the "Township") established an Agricultural Security Area ("Agricultural Security Area") according to the Agricultural Security Area Law, 3 P.S. §901, et seq, as amended; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Agricultural Security Area, as modified, the Township has received an application to incorporate an additional parcel into the Agricultural Security Area; and

WHEREAS, the Board did not act on the application within the time prescribed by the Agricultural Security Area Law, as amended, and therefore pursuant to 3 P.S. Section 908 (a) and (c) of the Agricultural Area Security Law the application to be included in the Agricultural Security Area is "Deemed Approved" effective upon the expiration of 180 days from the date the proposal was originally submitted and the property is deemed adopted as part of Amity Township's Agricultural Security Area District.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that:

- 1. The Board declares, and accepts, the proposed additional parcels located at 187 Fancy Hill Road, Amity Township owned by William Moseley and Janice M. Moseley encompassing approximately 62.77 acres with Parcel I.D. Number # 24537603214934 as a "Deemed Approval" effective as of March 28, 2020 the statutory date of deemed approval. The application to add the additional parcel to the Agricultural Security Area is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.
- 2. That the said amended Agricultural Security Area District shall be afforded the protection provided by said Act 43, as amended, so as to encourage the continuing development and viability of agriculture within the Township of Amity.
- 3. This Resolution, together with the application to add the additional parcels to the Agricultural Security Area, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," shall be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Berks County, Pennsylvania and shall be filed with the Township Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee, the Township Planning Commission, the Berks County Planning Commission, the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture and all owners of the land which is the subject of this modification.

A map showing the boundary of the proposed agricultural area and boundaries of the properties owned by the undersigned landowners within the proposed agricultural security area should be attached to each copy of this form (A county tax map, US Geological Survey topographic map, or other map as specified by the local government). Properties owned by each petitioner shall be identified on each map. In cases of joint ownership, all owners must sign the proposal.




