# Amity Township Board of Supervisors <u>Meeting Minutes</u>

January 3, 2022

Call to Order/Pledge to the Flag

The January 3, 2022 meeting of the Board of Supervisors, held at the Township Municipal Building, 2004 Weavertown Road, Douglassville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, was called to order at 7:00PM by Kim McGrath. The following were in attendance:

Mr. Boland called for a motion to open the floor to nominate a Temporary Chairperson. Motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Hackett to open the floor. Motion passed unanimously. Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to nominate Mr. Boland as Temporary Chairperson. Motion passed unanimously. Motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Hackett to close the nominations and appoint Mr. Boland as Temporary Chairperson. Motion passed unanimously.

# Nomination/Appointment of Temporary Secretary

Motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Hackett to open the floor to nominate a Temporary Secretary. Motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Hackett to nominate Mrs. Kisch as Temporary Secretary. Motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Hackett to close the floor to nominations and appoint Mrs. Kisch as Temporary Secretary. Motion passed unanimously.

Vote by roll call: Mr. Jones – Mrs. McGrath, Mr. Hackett – Mrs. McGrath, Mrs. McGrath, Mrs. McGrath – accepted the appointment. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Boland turned the meeting over to the 2022 Chairperson, Kim McGrath.

Motion passed unanimously. Vote by roll call: Mr. Jones - Mr. Hackett, Mrs. McGrath - Mr. Hackett, Mr. Keifrider - Mr. Hackett, Mr. Hackett – accepted the appointment. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Boland turned the meeting over to Mrs. McGrath.

# **MINUTES**

Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to approve the minutes of December 15, 2021. Motion passed 4-0.

#### **FINANCE**

Mr. Keifrider moved, seconded by Mr. Jones to approve the following disbursements:

\$ 137,993.16 General Fund \$ 62,000.00 Fire Fund \$ 50,551.55 Sewer Fund \$ 8,404.02 EDU/Capital Fund \$ 1,640.00 Monocacy Hill Fund \$ 3,561.67 Capital Fund \$ 264,150.40 Total

Mr. Jones questioned Check #30433 payable to *Builders Specialty Service* for truck parts. Mr. Bingaman stated Mr. Moore was not in attendance and could answer questions at the January 19<sup>th</sup> meeting. Mr. Jones asked if *Kozloff/Stoudt* has submitted all bills for 2021. Mr. Boland stated he believed billing was current through 11/30/2021 or 12/15/2021. Mrs. McGrath questioned Check #30468 payable to *Berks County Planning Commission*. Mr. Bingaman stated the annual payment is for membership to the County UCC Appeals Board. Mr. Boland stated many municipalities become members because very few appeals are actually filed and the diversity required of board members. Mr. Keifrider asked if the Township was billed monthly by *Ridge Support Technologies*. Mr. Bingaman stated invoices were paid monthly by contract, when the administration and Police both subscribed to Ridge. Since the Police migrated to another IT provider, the Township is now billed for a block of time based upon 2021 usage patterns. Motion passed 4-0.

The Board reviewed the *Overtime by Department Report* and had no questions.

## **REPORTS**

None

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

*Tax Collector Appointment* – Mr. Boland stated the Township accepted the resignation of Dean Fronheiser at the December 15<sup>th</sup> meeting and needed to appoint a Tax Collector. Mrs. McGrath stated Lisa Bingaman volunteered, in writing, to serve. Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to appoint Lisa Bingaman as Amity Township's Tax Collector and fulfil duties until the next municipal election, without compensation from the Township. Mr. Boland stated a candidate will run for the position in 2023 and be elected by the taxpayers. Motion passed 4-0.

**Emergency Services Department** – Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to adopt **Resolution 22-01**, establishing the Amity Township Emergency Services Department and naming the member companies as: the Amity Fire Company (Berks County, Station 49), the Monarch Fire Company (Berks County, Station 6), and the Western Berks Ambulance Association as the Emergency Services Company. Motion passed 4-0.

Appointment of Emergency Services Committee Members – Mr. Bingaman stated it was the Board's desire to have two Amity Township residents with current or previous emergency services experience and who were not affiliated with Amity and Monarch Fire Companies or the Township to review recommendations from the VFIS Fire Study. The Township received two letters of interest. One was from an Amity Township resident and one from a Douglass Township resident. After a brief discussion, Mrs. McGrath asked to have staff re-post the notice asking for volunteers who are Amity Township residents and tabled the matter to the January 19<sup>th</sup> meeting.

#### **SOLICITOR**

Mr. Boland had nothing to report.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

2022 Fee Schedule – Mr. Keifrider asked if Business Registrations and renewals were new fees. Mr. Bingaman stated Ordinance 324 was adopted in August, but the Fee Schedule was not amended because letters needed to be mailed to businesses notifying them of the requirements. After a brief discussion, the Board requested the registration renewal be changed from \$60.00 to \$25.00. Mr. Bingaman stated the Ordinance to address illegal sewer connections was tabled. Further information has become available indicating actual televising of laterals must be done and submitted to the Township. The Ordinance draft will be revised and provided for additional Board comments. Mrs. McGrath questioned violation fees for Police appear with the verbiage "in accordance with State Law". Chief Smith stated some fees are established by the State; and therefore, municipalities can not set fees in excess of those established by the State. Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to adopt Resolution 22-02 setting the 2022 Fee Schedule as presented, with exception of Business Registration Renewals fee set at \$25.00. Motion passed 4-0.

Tax Resolutions – Mr. Bingaman stated the proposed Resolutions would reaffirm the existing taxes. Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to adopt the Real Estate Transfer Tax Resolution 22-03, the Per Capita Tax Resolution 22-04, and the Earned Income Tax and Local Services Tax Resolution 22-05. Motion passed 4-0.

**Appointment of CAO for Pension Plans** – Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to adopt **Resolution 20-06**, appointing Troy S. Bingaman as the Chief Administrative Officer for the Non-Uniform and Police Pension Plans. Motion passed 4-0.

Appointment of CPA for 2021 Audit – Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to adopt **Resolution 22-07**, appointing **Herbein & Company, Inc.** as the Township's Certified Public Accountants for the audit of 2021. Motion passed 4-0.

Legal Representation at Property Maintenance Hearing – Mr. Bingaman requested Board approval for Kozloff/Stoudt to represent the Township at an upcoming property maintenance hearing for a retention pond between Russell Avenue and Firethorn Drive. The property owner has failed to maintain the retention pond, as required. Mr. Jones asked if attorney costs could be invoiced to the property owner if they are found guilty. Mr. Boland stated, they could at the direction of the courts. Mr. Keifrider moved, seconded by Mr. Hackett to authorize Kozloff/Stoudt to provide legal representation at the property maintenance hearing. Motion passed 4-0.

Animal Control Services – Mr. Bingaman stated staff would like to withdraw the request for Safety Net Sanctuary to provide Animal Control Services for 2022. The agreement and check was not yet mailed. Chief Smith stated the Township can hold dogs in the holding pens for 3 days, by Law. If the dog is not claimed, staff proposes having the dog transported by the Animal Control Officers to the Last Chance Ranch where the dog could be claimed or placed for adoption. Mr. Bingaman stated the Last Chance Ranch charges \$200.00/dog and the agreement could be executed if the Board so wished. The Chief stated he asked Safety Net Sanctuary for a total number of the dogs that were adopted last year and his question went unanswered. The Chief stated dogs would be handled by the Last Chance Ranch and cats would be handled directly by the Daywalts. Mr. Keifrider stated Last Chance Ranch would need to determine how they will handle billing if an owner comes to claim their pet. Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Keifrider to withdraw the motion for Safety Net Sanctuary to provide Animal Control Services for 2022. Motion passed 4-0. Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Keifrider to authorize execution of the agreement to pay \$200.00 per dog to Last Chance Ranch for adoptions. Motion passed 4-0.

## **EMPLOYEE/OFFICIAL REPORTS**

#### Manager's Report

Mr. Bingaman reported that *recycling collection* continues to spur complaints by residents. Staffing has been a real issue for Eagle Recycling as well as a severe COVID outbreak that had 18 workers leaving routes partially collected. Mr. Bingaman stated the Township was notified Wednesday afternoon that the route wasn't completed because of an illness and collection would be completed Thursday. Thursday at 6PM the Township was again notified they would be unable to finish and advised the route would be completed Friday. Mr. Bingaman stated the Facebook page is updated as soon as the Township is notified, but with late notifications residents sometimes call before the Township has been notified. Mr. Bingaman has requested the Township be notified as soon as possible to allow timely notification to residents. Mr. Boland stated the issue is not unique to Amity. Some contractors have used the force majeure clause to discontinue providing services under current contracts. Mr. Bingaman stated the Township pays approximately \$36.00 per household for recycling, suggesting re-bidding would result in a much higher fee. The Township could pay more per household and still face collection delays because many employers are facing the same issues.

#### **SUPERVISORS**

Mr. Keifrider reported approximately 70 to 80 *dead ash trees* were cut down on Monocacy Hill, leaving approximately 700 more dead trees to be addressed. Some of the dead trees were across walking trails and endangered hikers. Mr. Keifrider stated the remaining trees could be addressed with another 4 or 5 full work days. The consensus of the Board was that the dead tree removal be paid from the Monocacy Hill Fund.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Peter and Nicholas Ferrante, Boy Scout Troop #358, attended the meeting working on their Communication and Citizenship in the Community badges. Mr. Ferrante asked if the tax resolutions were written prior to the meeting. Mr. Bingaman stated resolutions are prepared prior to the meeting and adopted annually. Mrs. McGrath stated all townships in the state of Pennsylvania are required to reorganize on the same date. Mr. Boland stated that means that each Township meets at its own advertised times on one date for the purpose of reorganizing, reappointing staff and establishing taxes.

# **EXECUTIVE SESSION AND ADJOURNMENT**

At 8:00PM, with no further business, Mr. Jones moved, seconded by Mr. Keifrider to adjourn to the meeting.
