Santa Claus is coming to Town!





You didn't miss it! The Community Tree Lighting was postponed due to inclement weather. Join us at Amity Community Park this Sunday, December 18th at 5:00pm and dress warm!



Snow happens! When it does, Township crews clear snow and ice from over 64 miles of Township roads. Crews work hard to make sure roads are passable and safe. As you work to clear snow from your driveway, please realize crews do not intentionally throw snow closing your driveway. Following the tips below can help minimize the amount of shoveling you need to do after the plows go past.



As required by Ordinance, all vehicles should be removed from the street whenever there is 1" or more accumulation of snow and/or ice. Vehicles not moved will be fined \$40.00/day. Property Maintenance Code states where sidewalks exist, property owners are responsible to have a 2-foot wide path cleared of snow and ice within 24-hours after cessation of snowfall.

Amity Township, Chapter 7: Conduct, Subsection 7-125 prohibits placing items in the public street. Violators could be subject to fines. This includes mobile basketball hoops and recycling bins.

Please do not shovel or blow snow into the street. Doing so is a violation of the Municipal Code and hinderance to drivers and plow crews.

Lastly, if you have a fire hydrant near your home, please clear a 3-foot by 3-foot perimeter around the hydrant. From our crews and volunteer fire companies, thank you in advance for your cooperation!



Give your holiday tree new life by recycling it! Once the holidays are over, consider placing your tree curbside. Public Works crews will be around to collect and chip trees on Thursdays: January 5th, 12th and 19th; and on Tuesdays January 10th and January 17th. Crews will work through the Township using the same schedule as leaf collection.

When putting your tree out on trash night, make sure to place it away from the trash bins so your hauler doesn't take the tree by mistake!

Be sure to submit your **2021 Property Tax/Rent Rebate** application by December 31st. New this year, one-time bonus rebates have been approved for approved 2021 claimants of the property tax/rent rebate program.
