Amity Township was awarded a DCED Local Share Account Statewide grant in the amount of \$169,735.00. The funds will be used to purchase public sewer televising equipment and composite samplers. Township staff and appointed Wastewater Engineers work diligently to find and apply for funding, in an effort to keep costs as low as possible for our ratepayers.

The grant application process was quite competitive, The DCED received applications for eligible projects totaling more than \$414 million for the approximately \$56 million of funds available. The Board of Supervisors wish to extend sincere appreciation to Representative Mark Gillen and Senator Tracy Pennycuick for their support and endorsement of the Township's grant application.

TowerDIRECT Responding in Amity Township



TowerDIRECT began providing coverage in Amity Township on March 15th. The non-profit ambulance company houses (1) ALS unit in the Township at 824 E. Benjamin Franklin Highway. The TowerDIRECT team anticipates responding to approximately 1,700 calls in Amity. As part of the one-year contract, all Amity Township residents receive ambulance membership for 2023. This means Township residents will NOT incur out-of-pocket expenses for emergency services, consistent with the details of their insurance coverage. Township residents will also receive discounted transportation for using TowerDIRECT for non-emergency patient transport.

In a press release last week, Tower Health President and CEO, P. Sue Perrotty said, "As we continue to expand services to the communities we care for, we've also grown the TowerDIRECT team. Since the beginning of the year, we have added three new ambulances and a total of 28 new EMT's, paramedics and prehospital nurses.". The new ambulances and team members will help provide high-quality care to patients in Amity and neighboring Union Township.

TowerDIRECT is being dispatched by Berks County 911 Communications Center. You will also see TowerDIRECT providing medical care at community events such as parades, football games, our 2023 Harvest Fest and other large public gatherings.


