Board of Supervisors Approve Camera Installation




Take a walk or a hike!

All dogs must be on a leash and under your control at all times while visiting Monocacy Hill Recreation Area.

The Board of Supervisors authorized the purchase of swings for Lake Drive Park. Lake Drive is the Township's oldest park and is the most centrally located, providing recreation to many residents within walking distance. Over the past few years, the pavilion was replaced, new playground equipment was installed, new picnic tables were built, and most recently basketball, tennis and skate park surfaces were repaved, as well as the parking lot. 


