Mr. Boyer discussed the following items in LTL's review letter dated 10.4.19:

CONFORMANCE WITH THE SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE

Item #5- Mr. Boyer submitted a letter from the Port A Bowl explaining the number of employees and trucks expected to use the facility. Mr. Weber advised Mr. Boyer to submit the letter to TPD for a revised trip generation report that can then be used to calculate the appropriate Traffic Impact Fee.

Mr. Weber stated he prefers a first letter of review from each prior to approval however he does not see any issues with the plan that will cause major changes. Mr. Flatley moved seconded by Ms. Marburger to recommend the Board of Supervisor's grant Preliminary Plan approval contingent upon compliance with all items in LTL Consulting's letter dated 10.4.19 and Entech Engineering's letter dated 10.2.19. Motion carried unanimously. Mr. Boyer agreed to comply.
