CALL TO ORDER: Scott Weller called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On the motion of Pete Gaskins seconded by Keith Berry the minutes were approved 4-0 with Lisa Bingaman absent at the time of call.

VISITORS:

1. DANIEL BOONE MUSIC BOOSTERS: Movies in the Park: The Music Boosters want to do movies at the ACP. It would be 5 nights during the summer. They would be in need of electric. Troy Bingaman will look to see if the dates are open. They would need a certificate of insurance. A motion was made by Keith Berry to proceed with the event. The motion was seconded by Pete Gaskins. Approved 4-0. It will have to be approved by the Supervisors.
2. DBAA Representative: They want to attach a lock box to the Hill Road snack bar. It is to put the money box into at night . The issues at Hill Road bathrooms have to be looked into. What was suggested was to have a timer placed to lock at set times to make sure they are getting locked at night. A motion was made by Keith Berry to allow the lock box to be placed at Hill Road snack bar and was seconded by Pete Gaskins. Approved 4-0

1. LAKE DRIVE GRANT:
 - A. DCED: 2nd Grant to try to match up to \$500000
 - B. USTA: Tennis association grant program to rehab Lake Drive Tennis courts.
2. MUSIC IN THE PARK-OCTOBER: was to be June Jubilee. Crime Watch and Amity AC are to use the park with a temporary waiver for the alcohol being on the park property. The Township is going to put up snow fencing to mark off the drinking sections.
3. SUMMER PROGRAM:
 - A. LEADER/COUNSELORS: Clearances and drug tests need to be completed. They also have to be certified in CPR and First Aid. June 2nd is a training day by Southern Berks EMS.
