3. Fence Repair at Hill Road: Some repairs were made to the fence, but there is still more to do.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Hunting on Open Space Permit: Someone was looking to have a Township Permit for archery hunting only. The only open space would be Monocacy Hill. Troy Bingaman will be asking for more information from Union Township on how they run theirs.
2. DBAA: Looking for a breaker to be turned on for Lake Drive big field that works on the scoreboard. Troy will be asking the road crew about turning the breaker on. There is also a request from John Gleason to have an outlet installed on field 40 batting cage. They need someone to do the trenching and they would have to get someone to do the electric and the rest of the work. Steve Lumas will have to approve the project.
