CALL TO ORDER / PLEDGE TO THE FLAG: Scott Weller called the meeting to order at 7pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

MANAGER'S REPORT:

1. DBAA: Trailer in the outfield of Lake Drive large field needs to be relocated off-site. The trailer is not licensed, is not Township property and could cause a liability issue for the Township if someone is injured. We picked up and delivered in-field mix to Hill and Lake upon the request of Mr. Breen.
2. FIELD USE REQUEST: Requests are coming in to use Township fields. Just a reminder, after April 1<sup>st</sup> we will begin approving these requests in the order they were received.
3. HILL ROAD PAVILION: Staff obtained quotes to replace the roof on Hill Road Pavilion. We hope to obtain Board approval to move forward with this project in the near term.
4. AMITY COMMUNITY PARK: Multiple trees will be planted in the park as a result of trees that were not wanted by the residents in the Faust Subdivision (corner of Hill Rd and Old Airport Rd). A few trees will also be planted at Hill and Lake Dr Parks.
5. SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM: The YMCA has opted not to continue running a summer camp in the Township. Attendance was not very good last year so they were busing Amity kids to another facility for camp.

6. SUMMER TENNIS PROGRAM: AI reached out to Kim Cubero to determine if there would be a summer tennis program this summer. To date, I have not heard back from Kim.
7. WHEELER FIELDS/OPEN SPACE: Park Lane Hobbies is hoping to construct a macadam track on the former Wheeler Field. They would like the Township to apply for grant funding since we are the recipient of the facility. Nellie is working on obtaining labor quotes. If we can get the necessary support letters and quotes for both labor and materials, we will attempt to make applications.
