

Dewatered Digested Sewage  
Sludge, Grit & Screenings  
Hauling & Disposal

Amity Township requests proposals to remove and dispose of dewatered digested sewage sludge and other solid wastes from its wastewater treatment plant located at 120 Old Philadelphia Pike, Douglassville, PA 19518, in Berks County, Pennsylvania. The Township is requesting proposals for several removal and disposal options and reserves the right to enter into a contract for any or all of such options. The quantities listed below are our estimates, and are subject to change, depending which removal and disposal option(s) is(are) selected. We are interested in a three (3) and five (5) year contract proposals for each option.

**Bid Item 1 - *Dewatered Digested Sewage Sludge Disposal*:** Remove and dispose of dewatered digested sewage sludge from the plant at a 15% to 26% solids concentration. Estimated annual quantity – 1,000 tons. Contractor shall furnish a 20 cubic yard roll-off container for Amity use to load sludge at the site. The full dumpster must be picked up the day after being called. The dumpster must be exchanged for an empty one or emptied and returned within three (3) hours. Bidder shall list frequency and content of required laboratory analyses.

**Bid Item 2 - *Sewer Grit and Screenings Removal*:** Remove and dispose of sewer grit and screenings from the plant. Estimated annual quantity - 40 cubic yards. Contractor shall furnish two (2) - 2 cubic yard containers for Amity use to load grit at the site. Bidder shall list frequency and content of required laboratory analyses.

Option A: Three Year Bid \$ \_\_\_\_\_/2-cu yd container 1x/week (containers provided by you)

Five Year Bid \$ \_\_\_\_\_/2-cu yd container 1x/week (containers provided by you)

The removal of sludge and grit, in whatever form and concentration, shall be in such volumes, at such times and frequencies as determined or approved by the Amity Superintendent.

The prices quoted above shall be "complete" and shall include all labor, equipment, and supervision for the removal from the plant in suitable vessels, for transportation and for ultimate disposal, in a permitted manner and at a permitted/approved site. Any and all permits, approvals, and licenses which may be required to accomplish the contract provisions from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection or any other regulatory or governmental agencies shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor. No Bid Bond required with submission of bid and No Performance Bond will be required upon award.

The Township will furnish access to the plant, to the point of loading, during normal working hours. Amity Township will provide required laboratory analyses of the sludge, grit, and screenings on a periodic basis.

Consideration of Award will be at the Board of Supervisors meeting to be held April 17, 2024 at 7:00PM.
