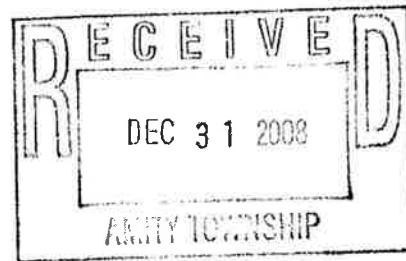

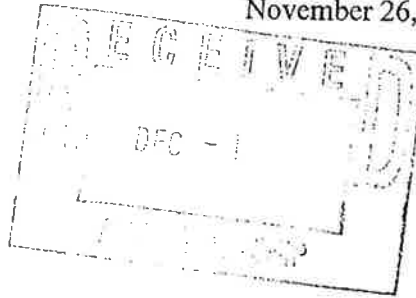


Amity Township (Township) is beginning the process of updating their Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan. This update is being initiated to address the planning requirements necessary to meet future public sanitary sewer service needs of the Township and that of the adjacent municipalities that are currently served or could potentially be served by the Township's wastewater treatment plant.

The Township's current Act 537 Plan, approved by PA DEP in December 2004, will provide much of the base information and data for this planning update. However, given the projected growth and development anticipated in the Township, it is important that the Township remain proactive and plan for future public sewer needs and the resultant upgrades that may be required at Township's wastewater treatment plant. As a result, the Township requests that each municipality provide their projected wastewater treatment needs. These needs should be projected for the next 10 years.





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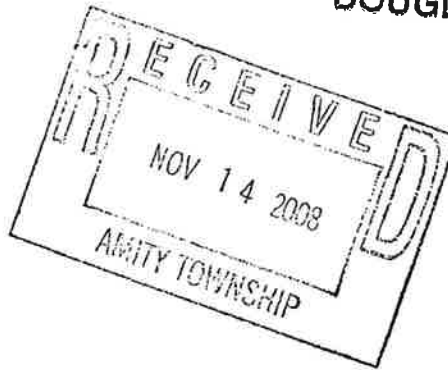
