Resolution for Plan Revision

**RESOLUTION OF AMITY TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
(hereinafter "the Township").**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537 known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as Amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, require the Township to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said Plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Township's service area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Amity Township hereby adopts and submits to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as an Update to the "Official Plan" of the Township, this Update to the Sewage Facilities (537) Plan.

The Township hereby approves and adopts this Official Act 537 Plan Update to meet the wastewater needs of the Township and for the design and construction of the upgrading and expanding of the Amity Township Wastewater Treatment Facility from its current capacity of 2.2 million gallons per day (MGD) to a capacity of 2.9 MGD in accordance with Alternative 1 detailed in the Plan. The Plan will be implemented in accordance with the implementation schedule set forth in the Executive Summary.

The Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.
