### LEAF AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Leaf Collection will begin by Zones beginning on November 12th. For your convenience, roads are listed below by the collection zones. Zone 1 may take upwards of two weeks, weather permitting. If your road is not listed in any of these zones, collection will commence following collection of Zone 3. The Road Crew will go through the Township a second time by zones beginning December 2nd, weather permitting.

Leaf Collection will be finished by December 13th, or with the first major snowfall.

Leaves should be raked into a pile at the curb, making sure leaves are not piled next to mailboxes or trees. <u>Please do not bag leaves!</u>

The Township will not pick-up bagged leaves. Keep storm sewer drains clear of leaves. Cars should not be parked over piles of leaves.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION —The Road Crew will be around the week of November 25th, 26th and 27th, BY REQUEST
ONLY! Please call 610-953-0016, during that week only, to let us know you have your yard waste bundled and ready for pick-up! Yard waste should be bundled, tied or placed in brown paper bags, no larger than 2'x2' and weighing no more than 20 pounds. No plastic bags, please!

If you miss Yard Waste Collection, bring yard waste and pile neatly next to the designated yard waste containers. We do not accept grass or leaves in yard waste containers!





Quarterly sewer rates will be increasing by \$26.00, to \$171.00 with the January 1<sup>st</sup> bills.

Be sure to update your auto pays accordingly.



The Amity Township recycling center gate is fully operational. A code is needed to access the recycling center. Township residents may apply in person, on our website or the link below.

If you are coming into the office to apply for a code, please bring your vehicle registration for the vehicle you will be using to access the recycling center. All vehicles that will be going through the gate must be registered along with any trailers.






# Holiday COOKING SAFETY













The Board of Supervisors have enacted legislation, requiring permits to hunt on Township lands (Monocacy Hill & Schuylkill River Tract). Hunting is limited to Township residents. The Permit can be completed in person at the Township office, M-Th 8am-4pm & Friday 8am-12pm OR electronically. A copy of your hunting license will be requested.

# A Homestead Holiday


Sunday, December 8, 2024 • 12-4pm

### **Snow Tips**



Crews do their best to remove snow quickly and efficiently. When there is 1" or more of snow and/or ice accumulation, vehicles must be removed from the street. Vehicles not in compliance will be fined \$40.00 per day.

International Property Maintenance Code, Section 302.3.1 state, where sidewalks exist, property owners are responsible to have a 2-foot wide path cleared of snow and ice within 24-hours after cessation of snowfall.

Please help our firefighters by making sure hydrants are accessible! If you have a fire hydrant near your house, please remove ice and snow, clear a 3-foot by 3-foot perimeter around the hydrant and clear a path from the hydrant to the street.

Remember, if you have recycling collection that day, please place recycling bins back from the curb.

As we approach the holidays, it should be a time of joy and cheer.

But for those who have lost loved ones, the holidays can also be a difficult time with periods of sadness. It's ok to not be ok. If you feel overwhelmed, please reach out for help. Operators are available to talk, text or chat any time, any day. Please call. Help is available when you need it!
