

The discount period ends April 30th.

The Tax Collector will be in until 7pm on April 30th accepting payments.

If you want a receipt showing your taxes were paid you must enclose/bring in the top and bottom portion of your tax bill and a self-addressed stamped envelope with your payment (if mailing).

#### Eligibility

This program supports Pennsylvania homeowners and renters who meet the following criteria.

#### Age Criteria

65 and older

#### Income Criteria

- Widows and widowers 50 and older
- · People with disabilities 18 and older
- In addition to the age requirements, to qualify for the Property Tax/Rent Rebate, your household income must be \$46,520 or less annually.

#### Application Deadline

Applications for the 2024 Property Tax/Rent Rebates are due by June 30, 2025. Under Pennsylvania law, the Department of Revenue evaluates the program before the June 30 deadline every year. If extra funds are available, the deadline is extended to December 31. Applications postmarked by that date will be accepted for processing.

#### WHAT IS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Household Hazardous Waste is any household product which is labeled:

CAUTION DANGER FLAMMARIE EXPLOSIVE. TOXIC CORROSIVE WARNING EXPLOSIVE POISON VOLATILE

or a combination of these characteristics. Look for warning or skull and crossbones on label. Use this list to identify and collect hazardous products which are no longer usable or wanted. Select a product suited for the job at hand but buy only what you can use entirely.

#### WHY COLLECT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE?

These collection days are intended to provide Berks County residents with a responsible way to dispose of old, unusable and unwanted hazardous products. Putting them in the trash or down the drain contributes to the pollution of our air and drinking waters.

#### HOW TO BRING MATERIALS TO OUR COLLECTION SITE?

- Do not mix the materials
- Tighten lids on all containers. If containers are leaking, pack in larger containers
- Bring all materials in original containers with labels, if possible.
- If not in original labeled container, please label

- Paint Thinners & Solvents Oil Based Paints, Varnishes and Stains (ABSOLUTELY NO LATEX PAINT WILL BE ACCEPTED)







#### Real ID to be in Effect on May 7th



Beginning May 7, Pennsylvanians will need a REAL ID-compliant license/identification card or other federally acceptable identification (such as a valid passport or military ID) to board domestic commercial flights or enter a military installation or federal facility that requires ID.

To get a REAL ID, you must bring your documents to a driver licensing center for verification in person. Learn about the specific items that are required to be issued a REAL ID. The website also offers the option to pre-verify online if your documents are already on file with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

REAL ID is optional. It is not required to drive, vote, access hospitals, visit the post office, access federal courts or apply for or receive federal benefits.



The Federal Trade Commission (TFC) says this texting scam is trying to both steal smartphone users' money while also phishing for their information, but the fraudsters are not being very selective with their targets.

The FTC has 3 tips to secure your data after receiving a suspicious text:

- · Don't click on any links or respond to a suspicious text.
- Check the number to see if the text is legit. Reach out to the state's tolling agency using a verified phone number or website not the one from the text.
  - Report and delete unwanted text messages. Use your phone's 'report junk' option to report unwanted texts or forward the message to 7726 (SPAM).



#### Email/Text Phishing Scams:

- Phishing: The email lures the victims into the scam with a variety of ruses such as enticing victims with a phony tax refund or threatening them with false legal or criminal charges for tax fraud.
- Smishing: A text or smartphone SMS message where scammers often use alarming language such as, "Your account has now been put on hold," or "Unusual Activity Report," with a bogus "Solutions" link to restore the recipient's account.

#### Bad social media advice:

 Another growing concern in 2025 continues with social media platforms routinely circulate inaccurate or misleading tax information, including TikTok where people share wildly inaccurate tax advice.

#### Ghost tax return preparers:

Most tax preparers provide outstanding professional service. However,
people should be careful of shady tax professionals and watch for
common warning signs, including charging a fee based on the size of the
refund. A major red flag or bad sign is when the tax preparer is
unwilling to sign the return. Taxpayers should never sign a blank or
incomplete return.
