

RESOLUTION NO. 25-11

A RESOLUTION OF AMITY TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO THE LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER APPROVAL OF D & P BRUTTO, LLC TRADING AS VINCENZO'S RISTORANTE ITALIANO AND PIZZERIA BY ITS MEMBER DOMENICO BRUTTO (APPLICANT) TO PERMIT LIQUOR SERVICE TO OUTDOOR SEATING AND OUTDOOR ENTERTAINMENT, UPON THE APPROVAL OF THE PENNSYLVANIA LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS, Amity Township (Township) is a municipality organized under and governed by the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, as amended and supplemented, 53 P.S. §65101, et seq. (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, on or about April 17, 2025, Applicant requested approval from the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township to amend the liquor license transfer approval which was originally approved on November 2, 2011; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 141 of 2000, the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township, held a public hearing on May 21, 2025, to receive public comment and testimony from the Applicant and all interested residents and property owners of the Township regarding the effect of the amendment to the liquor license transfer on the welfare, health, peace and morals of the residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing and after careful consideration of the testimony of all interested persons and the provisions of Act 141 of 2000, the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township approved the Application for Amendment to the Liquor License Approval of Applicant subject to conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, that the Application for Amendment to Liquor License Transfer Approval of D & P Brutto, LLC, trading as Vincenzo's Ristorante Italiano and Pizzeria by its member Domenico Brutto, to permit liquor service to outdoor seating and outdoor entertainment is approved, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Applicant must obtain approval to the changes to the liquor license from the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board prior to any liquor service to outdoor seating and outdoor entertainment will be permitted.
2. The Applicant shall at all times comply with the licensing requirements of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board and its rules and regulations and all Amity Township Ordinances, as amended from time to time.

3. The conditions imposed by the Board of Supervisors as part of this Decision and Resolution shall be formally accepted by the Applicants by their signatures on this Resolution. In the event the Applicants fail to sign this Resolution on or before May 30, 2025 to affirmatively indicate its acceptance of the conditions imposed, it shall be conclusively presumed that the request for Amendment to Liquor License Transfer Approval shall be denied.
